Year 5 Eden Project Trip

We are writing to you with exciting news about an upcoming school trip to The Eden Project in Cornwall. This will support our rainforest topic. When we are there, we will be completing a workshop based on identifying how to use the rainforest for its plants, food, shelter, water and health. We will also spend time enjoying all that the Eden Project has to offer.

The trip will take place on **Monday 5th October 2026. Children will need to be at school for 7.45am** as we plan to leave by 8am. We will be unable to wait for late comers. We will return at approximately 4.30pm, however we will inform via text of any delays/early arrival.

The cost of the trip, which includes the coach and entry cost is £22.29. Please make payment online via the School Gateway www.schoolgateway.com ensuring that you tick the consent box when you make your payment. **Please pay by Wednesday 30th September.** Unfortunately, if we do not receive enough voluntary contributions, then the trip will not be able to go ahead. If you would like to discuss payment for the trip, please visit the office.

Children will need a packed lunch for the day. They will also need to bring a drink in a water bottle. If required, packed lunches can be ordered via the School Gateway using the comments box. The cost will be £2.75 (unless free school meals) and the packed lunch will consist of a sandwich, apple & raspberry cake, packet of crisp and piece of fruit. If selecting a school packed lunch, please indicate your preference of ham or cheese sandwich filling, with or without salad on School Gateway. Following the introduction of Natasha's Law, if your child orders a school packed lunch, you are consenting to the content of the lunch and are aware of any allergens. Children will be given their packed lunches on the morning of the trip.

Children will need to come in school uniform but wear suitable shoes for walking such as trainers, they will also need to be prepared for the weather for that day. Layers would be best as one of the biomes is warm.
